PNA Renal Pathology Workshop

The material consists of scanned glass slides that can be viewed digitally, and selected jpeg images representing relevant immunofluorescence and electron microscopy findings. The cases span a broad spectrum of neonatal and childhood diseases, both hereditary and acquired, including glomerular, vascular and tubule-interstitial common and extraordinary entities. Anonymized actual pathology reports, a detailed comment describing the salient features and the differential diagnosis and or references supporting the diagnoses will be included. Twenty-five computers will be housed in a separate computer room stuffed with instructors.
